- 1       The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (McLeish and Taylor JJA) which dismissed as incompetent an application for leave to appeal an interlocutory decision of the County Court of Victoria (Judge Palmer), and which refused an application for review of a refusal by the County Court of Victoria (Judge Palmer) to certify an interlocutory decision.
- 2       The proposed appeal has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave.
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
