- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Mullins P and Brown JA, Boddice JA in dissent), which dismissed the applicant's appeal against conviction for one count of strangulation in a domestic setting, following a trial before Judge McCarthy and a jury in the District Court of Queensland.
- 2 The proposed appeal has insufficient prospects of success to warrant the grant of special leave to appeal.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
