- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Tasmania (Wood, Estcourt and Pearce JJ), which dismissed an appeal from the Supreme Court of Tasmania (Brett J) which, in turn, dismissed the applicant's appeal from a decision of the Legal Profession Disciplinary Tribunal dismissing the applicant's application against the respondent.
- 2 The application for special leave to appeal has no prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted. It would accordingly be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
