I ~~will~~ grant an extension of this patent until the 22nd August 1930, which the petitioners suggest is the date fixed by an order of the High Court of Justice in England for the expiration of the English Patent covering substantially the same invention ~~As~~ the Australian patent has expired, the extension will take the form of a new grant to the Aladdin Industries Ltd. from the date of the expiration of the Australian Patent No 712 of 1911 for a term ~~also~~ expiring on the 22 August 1930, subject to the usual provisions by way of protection, in respect of the period between the expiration of the patent and the date of this order. This is in accordance with the English practice, which I adopt.
