The only question in this appeal is whether the amount awarded by the learned trial judge should be reduced on the ground that the damage complained of and sustained by the respondent was the result partly of his own fault.

Mr. O'Sullivan has said all that could be said in support of the appeal, but we are satisfied that his Honour's finding that the damage was the result solely of the appellant's negligence was correct.

The appeal will, therefore, be dismissed with costs.
