## STATE OF HEM SOUTH VALUE AND STREAM

I do not think any differentiation is justified between the costs of the application for the injunction and the costs of the other interlocutory proceedings.

The order I make is that the action be dismissed with costs including costs of all interlocutory proceedings, the judgment being profaced by a recital that the plaintiff and the first two defendants agree that the action relates to the law of the Commonwealth and of the State of New South Wales as at the date of institution of the action.

I cortify for counsel in respect of all the interlocutory applications.

As no part of the order, I note that I shall intimate for the assistance of the taxing officer that appearance of senior counsel in the matters they attended appears to me to have been justified.
